- The abstract should be of 250-300 words and include five keywords.
- Title, Author's Name, Affiliation, Address and email address should be properly mentioned.
- The work should be original which has not been • previously presented, submitted or accepted for publication. The Abstract File should be submitted in MS Office Word only.

Guidelines for Paper

- The first page should contain the title of the manuscript and author's details (Name of the Author/s, Designation, Department, Name of the Organization, Address for correspondence, email ID and contact number).
- The Title of the Paper/Article should be in bold letters, manuscript typed in 12 point, Times New Roman Font, line spacing 1.5 and text not exceeding 3500 words fully justified (MS Office Word Only).
- Referencing should be in APA Style.
- Author should ensure that the plagiarism is less than 10%.
